Independent Analysts Find Trump Sales Tax Will Dramatically Raise Families' Taxes Nationwide: Independent analysts from the conservative Tax Foundation, the Center for American Progress, the Institute for Taxation and Economic Policy, the American Action Forum, and the Peterson Institute for International Economics have found that Trump's proposal to raise taxes on imported household goods that families buy would significantly increase tax burdens on the average household.

Methodology: Harris-Walz Estimates Are Based on Average of Five Independent Studies—\$3,954 Tax Increase on Average Family. The average of the estimates from the Tax Foundation (\$6,000), Center for American Progress (\$3,900), the American Action Forum (\$3,900), the Institute for Taxation and Economic Policy (\$3,370), and the Peterson Institute (over \$2,600) reflects an increase of \$3,954 in household costs.

Economists Agree: Trump’s National Sales Tax Would Cost Hundreds of Thousands of Jobs

The Tax Foundation found that Trump’s tariff plan and the retaliation from foreign governments (which respond to this kind of tax by levying their own), would cost the U.S. more than 1 million total jobs.¹

Morgan Stanley recently found that Trump’s household goods tax increase plan would lead to significantly higher inflation. “The inflationary effect happens more quickly, judging from history,” Morgan Stanley reports. Morgan Stanley forecasts a 0.9 percentage point increase in the PCE price index relative to baseline over one year under Trump’s plan. Economists agree that such an increase would also mean higher interest rates for American consumers and homeowners. GDP growth would slow by 1.4 percentage point “over several quarters,” according to Morgan Stanley. And Morgan Stanley estimated that monthly U.S. jobs growth would decrease by 50,000 to 70,000, which would push up unemployment.² Further, an analysis from the Peterson Institute for International found that an earlier version of Trump’s proposal to increase taxes on imported goods—which he doubled down on—would mean “US inflation rises 1.3 percentage points above baseline in 2025.”³

- **The Families of 231,000 Newborn Children in Wisconsin Will Receive New Harris \$6,000 Newborn Child Tax Credit During Harris' First Term:** The families of an estimated 58,000 newborns in Wisconsin each year will receive a new Harris newborn tax credit of up to \$6,000.⁴¹
- **In Total, 651,000 Wisconsin Families with 1,127,000 Wisconsin Children Would Receive a Harris Middle-Class Family Tax Credit:** Families will receive an expanded Child Tax Credit worth up to \$3,000 for each child over six years old and up to \$3,600 for each child under six.⁴²
- **320,000 Wisconsin Workers Will Receive an Expanded Earned Income Tax Credit of up to \$1,500.**⁴³
